

## External Advisory Board

- ✓ An External Advisory Board will be composed of the Principal Investigator, the Chairperson, the Vice-Chairperson, two (2) additional members of the Executive Committee, and three (3) nationally or internationally known scientists involved in cancer predisposition genetic screening and/or cancer research across the care continuum.
- ✓ The External Advisory Board may include other stakeholders, e.g., representatives of funding agencies, patient representatives, etc.
- ✓ The External Advisory Board will be engaged at a minimum every four (4) years.
- ✓ Members of the External Advisory Board will be nominated by members of the Executive Committee. The nomination must be accepted with a majority two thirds (2/3) vote.
- ✓ The External Advisory Board will provide non-binding advice regarding the
  - 5-year strategic direction of the CASCADE Consortium.
  - New areas of research that relate to the mission of the CASCADE Consortium.
