

**Full Membership** is granted to researchers or clinicians who have a PhD and/or MD degree and have received national, peer-reviewed funding in an area of cancer research as Primary Investigators or Co-Investigators.

**Site Investigators** with Full or Associate membership, represent each research or clinical site holding an affiliation with the CASCADE Consortium and have voting privileges. Site Investigators are chosen by each clinical site and are responsible for recruitment issues at their clinical site.

**Associate Membership** may be granted to researchers, clinicians, project personnel, or students who have not met the requirements for full membership but are involved in cancer predisposition research working collaboratively with a Full CASCADE Consortium member, and wish to be involved in the mission of the Consortium. Associate members do not have voting privileges, except if they are a Site Investigator of an affiliated site.

Full or Associate membership will be assumed upon a written request to the Consortium, accompanied by a 2 page Curriculum Vitae and a maximum 1 page Motivation Letter in English.

The Executive Committee will decide for the Full or Associate membership and present a slate at the annual meeting. Participation in the Consortium activities, including but not limited to participant recruitment, intellectual contribution to research-related activities, and attendance in meetings is expected for continued membership. Full and associate members should attend the annual meeting.
